## **PUSH ENTEROSCOPY INSTRUCTIONS**

Thank you for choosing Colorectal Surgical & Gastroenterology Associates for your procedure needs.

**Time involved:** Approximately 2 to 3 hours from walk in to walk out.

<u>Prep:</u> Do not eat or drink anything (including water) after midnight. Medications that you take on a regular basis (except those listed below) may be taken on the morning of your procedure with a small amount of water.

## Absolutely NO Chewing Tobacco or Dip Products After Midnight!!!

<u>Sedation</u>: You will be sedated with an IV conscious sedation or Propofol for this procedure which is used to relax you and make you feel sleepy. As a result, time will appear to pass very quickly and you will not recall much or, perhaps, even anything at all of what has happened. <u>Therefore, you must bring someone with you to drive you home that is willing to accept the responsibility for your care. If you are taking Contrave, Suboxone, Naltrexone, Naloxone and/or Narcan, please notify our office to make sure your procedure is scheduled with Propofol.</u>

If you are having an EGD because of swallowing problems, please follow the medication recommendations below.

<u>SEVEN DAYS BEFORE:</u> Stop taking <u>Plavix (Clopidogrel)</u>. <u>Effient or Brilinta</u>. We recommend that you seek permission from your prescribing physician to stop taking Plavix. If you wish to discuss this issue further, please call or make an appointment to see you physician at Colorectal Surgical & Gastroenterology Associates.

<u>THREE DAYS BEFORE:</u> Stop taking <u>Ticlid</u>, <u>Coumadin</u>, <u>Warfarin</u>, <u>Xarelto</u>, <u>Eliquis or Aggrenox</u>. We recommend that you seek permission from your prescribing physician to stop taking Ticlid, Coumadin, Warfarin, or Aggrenox. If you wish to discuss this issue further, please make an appointment to see your physician at Colorectal Surgical & Gastroenterology Associates.

**ONE DAY BEFORE:** Stop taking Lovenox

- \*\*PLEASE CONTINUE TO TAKE YOUR ASPIRIN DAILY\*\*
- \*\*IF YOU USE A NEBULIZER OR INHALER, PLEASE REMEMBER TO BRING IT WITH YOU TO YOUR PROCEDURE\*\*

<u>PROCEDURE INSTRUCTIONS:</u> Do not eat or drink anything (including water) after midnight. Medications that you take on a regular basis (except those listed above) may be taken on the morning of your procedure with a small amount of water.

Please bring: A list of all of your medications to the hospital with dosage and frequency information.
